

## **EU NMSs for EU, status NAS in the EU**

### **ABSTRACT**

Many EU member states are currently working on National Adaptation Strategies. Each country faces different challenges and opportunities in that respect, hence various approaches to National Adaptation Strategies apply. In this session an overview is given of the current status of the NAS in EU member states and examples are given of approaches to the design of a NAS. In the session we want to share experiences and identify do's and don'ts, opportunities and challenges, and possible ways forward. Whereas this session applies the perspective of the demand side of the NAS, its findings will be used and elaborated on in the in the session ECS 1.6: "How can NMSs contribute more to NAS in EU" in which there is explicit room for the perspective of the supply side (e.g. NME's) and its potential contribution to National Adaptation Strategies.
